INTRODUCTION

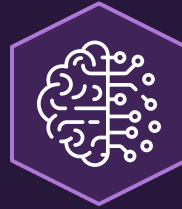

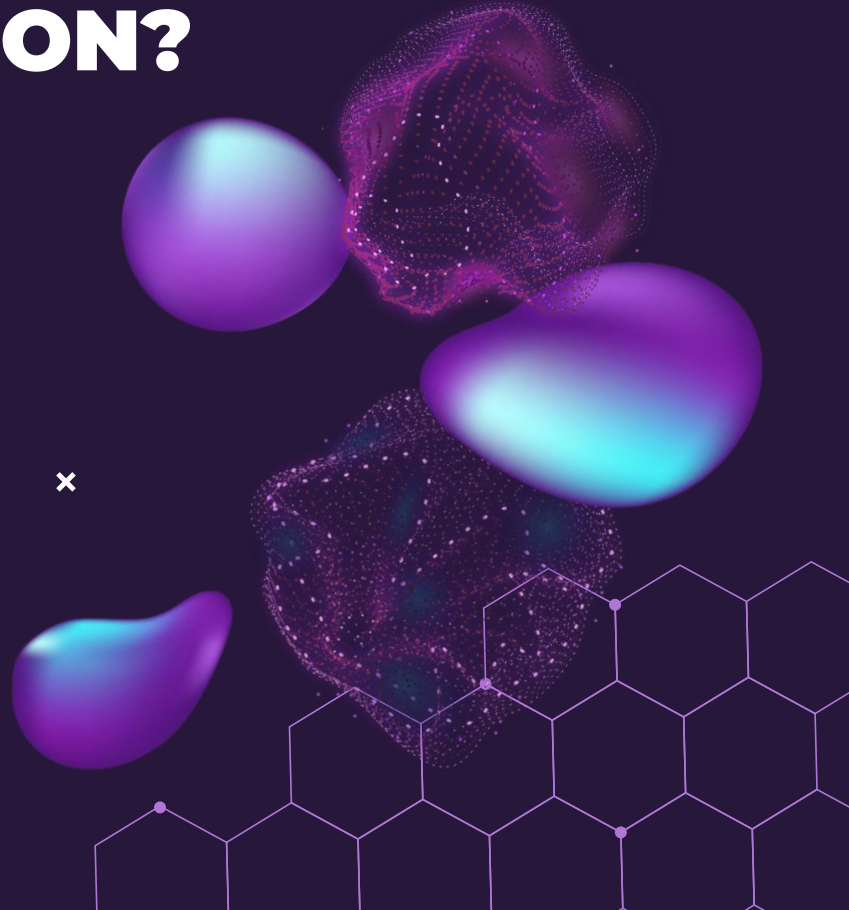
HOW IS GAMIFICATION USED IN EDUCATION?

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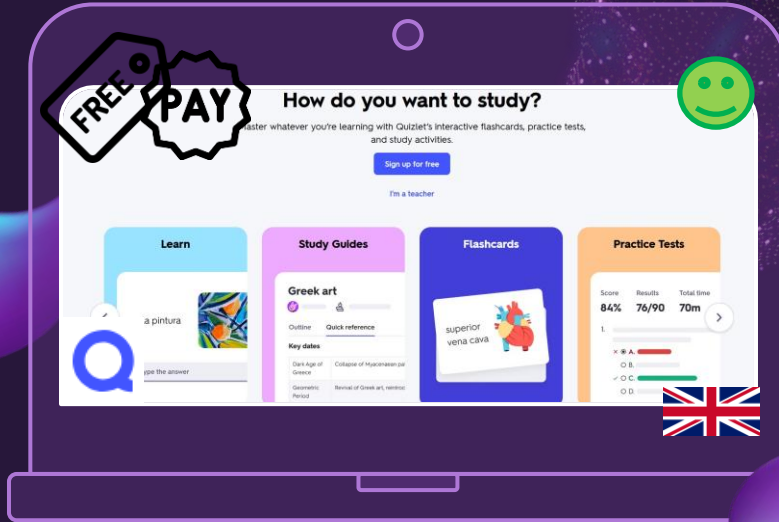
- ◆ **Personalized Learning Paths** - AI algorithms analyze student performance, preferences, and progress to create individualized learning paths.

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- ◆ **Gamified Analytics** - AI visualizes progress and achievement data in game-like dashboards, motivating students to reach higher scores or unlock badges.



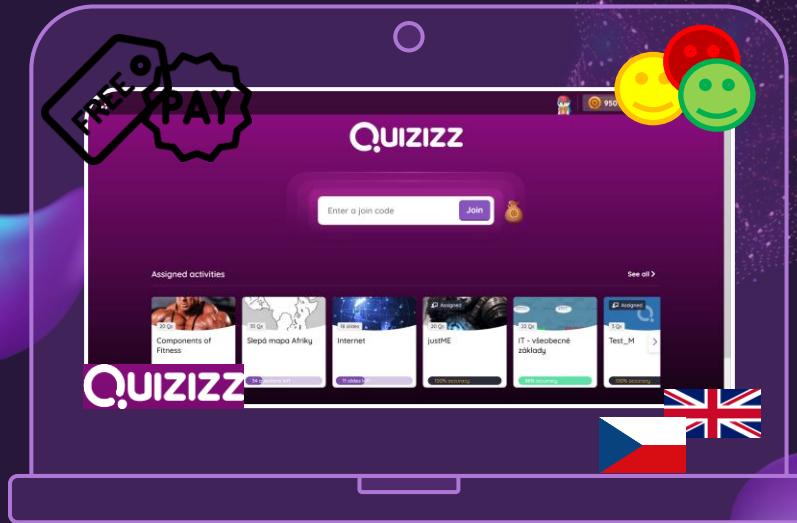

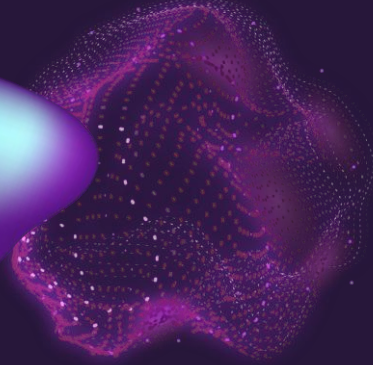
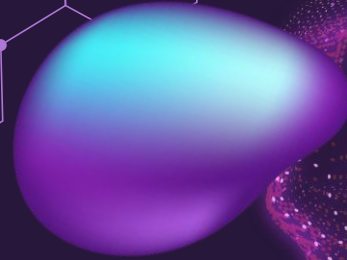
A chatbot is a software application designed to simulate human-like conversations with users, typically through text or voice, to provide assistance, answer questions, or perform tasks.



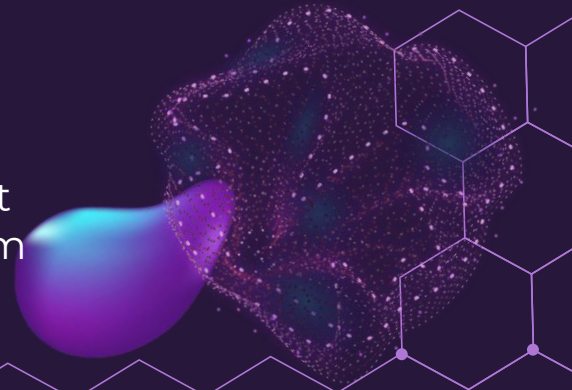
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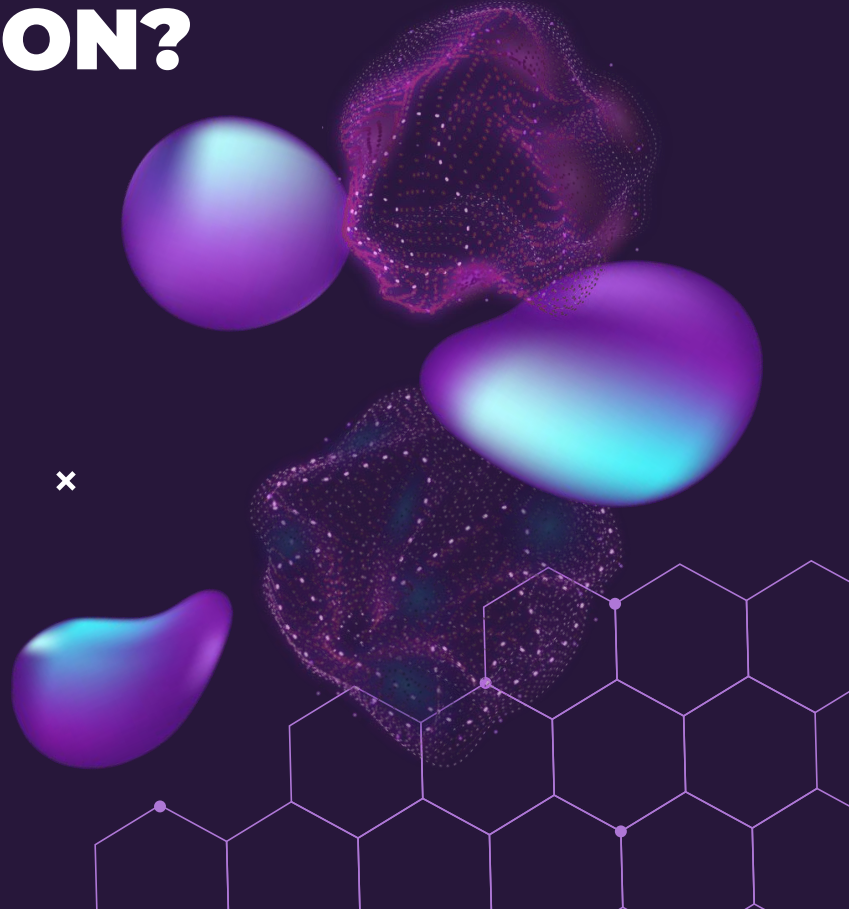
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HOW TO USE CHATBOTS IN EDUCATION?

- ◆ **24/7 Access to Resources:** Chatbots can serve as round-the-clock assistants for accessing study materials, lecture summaries, or educational videos.
- ◆ **Language Learning Partner:** They can engage students in conversational practice for foreign languages, and correcting grammar.
- ◆ **Brainstorm ideas, Interactive Quizzes, Homework Assistance**



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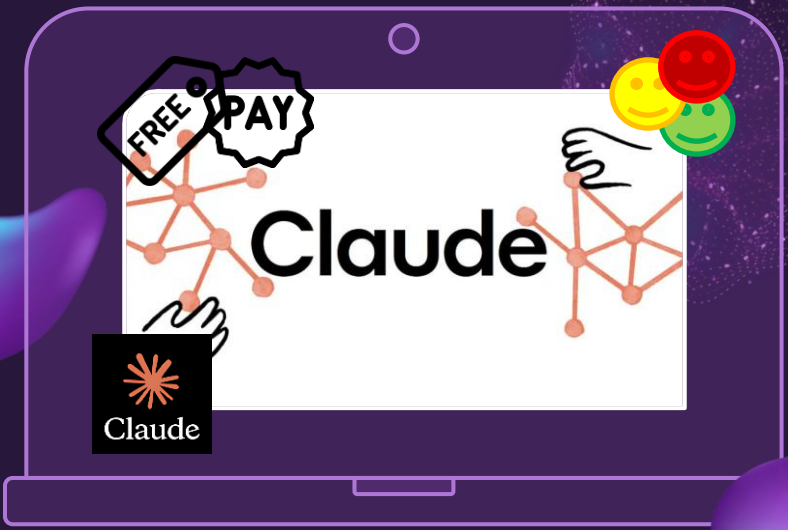
